Please keep in mind: only items certified by the manufacturer which meet government standards qualify for these credits.

The following home energy credits will expire 12/31/2022:

Product:

Solar Energy Systems, Geothermal Heat Pumps, Small Wind Turbines, and Fuel Cells

(Existing homes and new construction qualify; principal and secondary homes qualify; rentals do not qualify)

Biomass Fuel Cells

Credit:

26% of the cost, placed in service before 1/1/23

22% of the cost, placed in service before 1/1/24

26% of the cost, placed in service before 12/31/22
